

What is the ExamBank **NOGGIN HOGGIN'** Challenge?

The Noggin Hoggin' Challenge is ExamBank's zany brainchild. It is a multi day, elimination-style challenge designed for students across Canada.

The mind bending puzzles are developed by educators as a fun way to integrate technology and inquiry-based learning into the daily lives of students. The question style is multi-disciplinary, meaning that it integrates different subject areas and skills. Students will essentially be engaged in an online treasure hunt, learning to identify and consult reputable sources to solve a problem.

These online challenges consist of a series of six puzzles which are available to all registered participants. It is free to play, however in order to submit answers and compete for prizes, a user must have registered on the site and be a verifiable student attending a Kindergarten to Grade 12 school in Canada.

Although students must register individually, teachers may choose to work on some of the weekday puzzles with their class. Students are also encouraged to engage their families and friends in these challenges.

Game Play Summary

The dates of upcoming challenges are available online. Register today for the next challenge!

A challenge officially begins when the first question is released at the beginning of the week.

Participants have until the end of the day to submit their answer, and the next morning the second / next puzzle is revealed, and so on until the last day.

Time penalties are applied and compounded for incomplete or incorrect responses over the span of the contest, and penalty minutes are applied to the final, time-sensitive question on the 6th day. Competitors are ranked by the order in which they submit correct answers to this final question. Grand prizes are awarded to the top three competitors, as well as numerous secondary prizes.

Active questions are only viewable to registered players, but as each question expires, the problem and its correct solution will become available to everyone.
